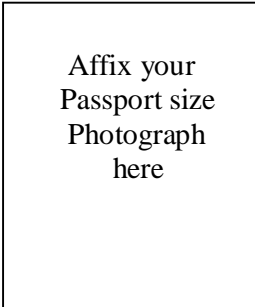

# **Constitutional Rights of Minorities**

**Trinity Central School** belongs to Capuchin Friars Service Society®. It is a society with Minority Rights protected under the Constitution of India Articles 29 & 30

## **Article 29, Protection of Interests of Minorities**

- 1.** Any Section of the citizens residing in the territory of India or any part, thereof having a distinct language, script or culture of its own shall have the rights to conserve the same.
- 2.** No citizen shall be denied admission into any educational institution maintained by the State or receiving aid or of State funds on the grounds only of religion, race, caste, language or any of them.

## **Article 30, Right of Minorities to establish and Administer Educational Institutions.**

- 1.** All minorities, whether based on religion or language, shall have the right to establish and administer educational institutions of their choice.
- 2.** In making any law providing for the compulsory acquisition of any property of an educational institution established and administered by a minority, referred to in clause (1), the state shall ensure that the amount fixed by or determined under such

law for the acquisition of such property is such as would not restrict or abrogate the right guaranteed under the clause.

**3.** The state shall not, in granting aid to educational institutions, discriminate against any educational institution on the ground that it is under the management of a minority, whether based on religion or language.

**As a Minority Institution we enjoy:**

- ✓ The right to establish and administer educational institution of our choice.
- ✓ The freedom of choice of the medium of institution.
- ✓ The right not to be nationalized.
- ✓ The right to appoint our own teachers.
- ✓ The right to admit children belonging to our religion.
- ✓ The right to give religious instruction to Christians, the right to celebrate our religious feasts.

## **Instructions to Parents and Students**

### **I. Disciplinary regulations**

1. Every student must wish the members of the staff on the occasion of his first meeting them for the day, within the School precincts or outside.

2. No student is allowed to leave class room without the permission of the teacher or until the class is dismissed. No student is allowed to leave the school premises during school hours including short break without the written permission of the Principal or his deputy.

3. During the absence of a Teacher from the class, the class Prefect will maintain discipline. The students must obey the class Prefect appointed to maintain order.

4. Every conversation in the School Campus should be strictly in English only. Each and every student must follow it without fail.

5. **Punctual and regular attendance** is insisted upon. Leave of absence from School for weddings, functions etc. must be applied for in writing well in advance of the planned leave. The general terms of excuse such as “for business”, “for some ceremony” is not sufficient.

a) Student who has been absent from School or has arrived late must produce the calendar with the leave note entered and signed in the Leave record by a parent or guardian. This must be counter signed by the Principal or his deputy, without which entry into the classroom is not allowed and will then be marked as absent. In case of absence for a day only, the class teacher may countersign the leave record.

b) When a student is absent due to prolonged illness for more than three days, the parent must inform the school authorities. Absence for illness must be supported with evidence such as a doctor’s medical certificate or clinic / hospital medical record.

c) If a student is suffering from any communicable diseases such as chicken pox, measles, conjunctives, etc, parents are requested not to send the ward to the school until it is completely cured.

d) If a student present in the forenoon sessions requires leave in the afternoon, a letter should be brought from the Parents and that must be countersigned by the Principal or his deputy.

e) When the student is absent, the parents must complete the leave record in the school calendar

f) Disciplinary action will be initiated on the students found absenting without prior permission or without proper authorization

g) If a student is absent for any reasons including illness, evaluations or tests will not be advanced/ postponed or re- conducted.

6. The school calendar must be brought to School every working day, including test and examination days. Specimen signature of the parents (or guardian) has to be shown by every student on the student information form in the calendar. Parents are also required to sign at the end of the disciplinary regulations section as an acknowledgement of the School Rules and Regulations.

7. Students attending class or any other function in the School are expected to be neatly dressed in School uniform. Failure to wear the prescribed uniform to class shall entail the student being sent home marked absent for the day.

8. Books, periodicals or papers of any objectionable character should not be brought to the school

**9. Mobile phones, Digital cameras, mp3 players, iPods, Walkman, Fancy Watches, Expensive jewellery is strictly prohibited inside the campus. If brought the same may be confiscated and not returned.**

10. Playing in the class rooms or in corridors is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be initiated on the students found playing.

11. Students should be diligent in their duties and come to class well prepared with daily lessons and with their homework carefully done.

12. It is the duty of the each and every student to keep their class-room and other places in and around the School clean and in order. They need to cultivate the habit of using the dustbin.

**13. The student's behavior at all times reflects their personality. Any student who is persistently insubordinate to teachers, repeatedly and willfully violates rules or indulge in mischief or is guilty of malpractice or found with habitual inattention to School work, obscenity in word or act and other offences such as habitually coming late to class, damaging School property particularly writing/ inscribing/defacing on desks or walls etc., will be given warning. If this behavior still continues he or she will be temporarily or permanently suspended from the school with reasons duly recorded in writing which may include issue of a Transfer Certificate.**

## **II. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

### **A. Uniforms:**

The school uniform gives the student a sense of belonging and the pride of a special identity.

Students should wear uniform as follows:

**Regular uniform:** Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

**House Colours uniform:** Wednesday.

**Scouts and Guides:** Wednesday.

**Colour dress:** Saturday

- Students have to wear the shoes and socks of his/her size. They must have footwear as specifies by the School. Uniform shoes and socks will be worn on all days, except on rainy days.
- Blazers are compulsory for the students of Std.10 on Formal Occasions.
- Students are allowed to wear the colour dresses on their birthday provided that their outfits are decorous and confirm to the spirit of Indian culture.

Note: ***Girls will plait their hair on two sides on schooldays. Girls should wear white ribbons with regular uniform and white ribbons with house –colour uniform.*** Girls are strictly not permitted to wear fancy / colourful clips or hair bands. Applying mehendi /nail polish is strictly not allowed.

### **B. Science and computer laboratories:**

Students are allowed to use Science and computer laboratories at school only under the supervision of the subject faculty.

Students are not permitted to carry any chemicals /apparatus, CD's, pen drives into the laboratory without the prior approval of the subject faculty.

Students are warned that tampering with the settings of the computer systems to view objectionable visuals or graphics may lead to suspension or being expelled from the school.

### **C. Transportation**

The transport facility is available to all the destinations. Bus routes and schedules are prepared after an intensive route study, duly considering the convenience of all students availing the bus facility.

1. Students will not be allowed to change buses/routes/bus stops under any circumstances. Only the authorized persons should drop and pick up the students from their designated stops.

2. Parents are not allowed to travel by school vehicles or accompany the children to the school by school vehicles.

3. If there is no responsible guardian to receive a child in the evening, the child will be brought back to the School Campus.

4. Students should maintain order and remain seated while in transit. No indiscipline will be tolerated in the bus.

5 Temporary change of bus is thoroughly discouraged. However, if absolutely necessary, prior written permission may be obtained from the Principal.

6. If on account of torrential rains the School is unable to function on a particular day the School vehicle will not be sent. Parents may call up the School Office and verify whether it is a holiday for the School on that specific day. Off-course the message will be sent through 'TRICES'

### **D. Fee Regulations:**

The Payment of the fees (tuition, bus and midday meals) can be done in THREE Installments or in June itself.

1<sup>st</sup> Installment      At the time of Admission (by June)

2<sup>nd</sup> Installment      In the month of September

3<sup>rd</sup> Installment      In the month of January

### **E. Working Days:**

1. The school follows a five-day (Monday-Friday) week schedule.

2. However, there will be compulsory activity classes like Karate, Taekwondo/judo, Music, Dance, Abacus, Robotics, Drawing etc., on Saturday. The time table as follows:

9-15 to 10-15 : First Activity Class

10-30 to 11-30 : Second Activity Class

11-30 to 12- 30 : Talent hour

Participation in at least one Activity class is compulsory. For the rest of the time the student should sit in his/her respective class and study or can meet the subject teachers to learn more.

**F. Office working hours:**

The school office functions from 9.00a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on week days. The office remains closed only on Sundays and Public holidays.

**III. Examinations**

1. Unit tests are held twice during the academic year and at the end of I & II terms Semester exams are held.

2. Tests and exams are compulsory. If due to illness one cannot attend, it must be reported to the Principal immediately and a medical certificate furnished.

3. Projects assigned and the last date to submit the same is clearly mentioned in the monthly events of the calendar. Projects submitted after the last date will not be entertained/marked.

3. Malpractice in an examination disqualifies a student for the whole examination and such students will not be permitted to write the remaining examinations. Students caught for malpractice are also subject to being removed from the School, at the discretion of the Principal.

4. Promotion to the higher class will be determined on the basis of the performance throughout the year with due weight age for the different tests / examinations.

5. If a student fails in the tests and exams continuously in many subjects will be asked to take the Transfer Certificate.

6. Results declared at the end of the year are final in all cases and they will not be reconsidered, nor will the answer papers be shown or allowed to take home.

7. Parents must sign the Progress Report issued at the end of each exams. No erasure of any kind will be permitted in the Report.

8. Students will not be allowed to sit for the final examination unless their fees have been paid in full before the examination

**IV. The Safety of our Children**

-Parents/Students shall not attempt to stop the buses in any other place other than their own designated stops. In such circumstances written permission from the Principal is a must.

-Parents of small children shall accompany the child and help the child board the bus in the morning, and receive the child by waiting on the left side (door side) of the bus in the evening. This is very important because small children lack the knowledge of traffic rules. They have a tendency to run and cross the road in a hurry as soon as they get off the bus. Therefore, parents are requested to come and hold the child then they get off the bus, and cross the road only after the school bus has left the bus stop.

-Parents are requested to educate the children constantly about the basics of traffic rules and show them the right example when using the road or driving a vehicle.

**V. Parental attention to certain disciplinary matters:**

1. Parents and guardians are expected to cooperate with the School authorities by enforcing discipline and regularity at home with their child(ren). In order that lessons may be duly prepared and completed, students should devote sufficient time for private study. On holidays more time should be devoted to study at home. If parents do not insist on regular attendance and home study, the results are sure to be disappointing to them.
2. Parents must ensure that their child attends School regularly, completes all assignments, devotes time for reading, writing, and keeps in step with the class lessons and participate in all the School activities.
3. Letters or any intimation sent to parents must be properly responded. Parents when summoned to School must understand that there is something very important to be discussed with them. if a parent does not respond, such a parent will be asked to withdraw the child from School.
4. Parents and guardians are recommended to contact the Class Teacher at least once each term to ascertain with the school authorities that the conduct and progress of the student has been satisfactory, at a minimum. Parents are also required to contact the teachers during class wise PTA meetings indicated in the calendar to ascertain the progress and conduct of the students.
5. Parents are welcome to meet the Class teachers on every 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon (except on public holidays) in order to discuss about their ward's day-to-day progress and behavior. Teachers are not available to the parents on other Saturdays as they have staff meeting and Seminars.
6. Parents and guardians (or other parsons) are not allowed to enter any of the class rooms during the class hours without the Principal's permission. No outsider is allowed to contact any student directly in the school campus.
7. Parents and students are discouraged strongly from giving any kind of gifts to teachers/members of the staff.
8. Students are not permitted to bring money to the School, unless there is a clear instruction from the School to bring money for a particular purpose.
9. Parents are requested to write the child's name and class on his/her belongings such as water-bottles, tiffin-carriers, umbrellas etc.
10. Parents must avoid criticizing any teacher/School in the presence of the pupil. Communicate with the Principal in writing if you have any genuine grievance.
11. Parents have a responsibility to encourage modest, decent and tasteful dressing habits, conforming to acceptable social mores, among children from very early stages of their development.
12. Parents must see the Progress Records of their children and help them rectify their defects as regards study and conduct.

13. Parents, staff and students are strictly prohibited from speaking to media with regard to any school affairs.

14. Parents are requested to refer to the Calendar regularly; else it will fail in its purpose. The home work diary / calendar must be signed by Parents / guardians every day.

15. Parents are requested not to send the child to school if he/she is suffering from any contagious disease like chicken pox, measles, conductivities, jaundice etc.

Home is the first School for children, and the second is the School itself. A child is shaped by both. The healthier the co-operation between the two, the more fruitful will be the efforts. Therefore, **PARENTS' WHOLE-HEARTED CO-OPERATION IS EXPECTED IN THESE MATTERS TO MAINTAIN DISCIPLINE AND DECORUM**


